<p>1.Public Health attestation</p> <p>I, the undersigned official veterinarian, hereby certify, that the animals described in this certificate:</p> <p>1.1. come from holdings which have been free from any official prohibition on health grounds, for the past 42 days in the case of brucellosis, for the past 30 days in the case of anthrax and for the past six months in the case of rabies, and, have not been in contact with animals from holdings which did not satisfy these conditions;</p> <p>1.2. have not received:</p> <p>-any stilbene or thyrostatic substances,</p> <p>-oestrogenic, androgenic, gestagenic or b- agonist substances for purposes other than therapeutic or zootechnic treatment (as defined in Council Directive 96/22/EC);</p> <p>2.Animal Health attestation:</p> <p>I, the undersigned official veterinarian, hereby certify, that the animals described above meet the following requirements:</p> <p>2.1. they come from the territory with code: (3) which, at the date of issuing this certificate :</p> <p>(a) either has been free for 24 months from foot-and-mouth disease, for 12 months from rinderpest, African swine fever, classical swine fever, swine vesicular disease and vesicular exanthema, and for 6 months from vesicular stomatitis, and (5) or</p> <p>(a) (i) has been free for 24 months from foot-and-mouth disease (5), for 12 months from rinderpest, African swine fever, vesicular exanthema, classical swine fever (5) and swine vesicular disease (5), and for 6 months from vesicular stomatitis, and</p> <p>(ii) has been considered free from foot-and-mouth disease (5), classical swine fever (5) and swine vesicular disease (5), since (date), without having had cases/outbreaks afterwards, and authorised to export these animals by Commission Decision / /EC, of (date), and (5)</p> <p>(b) where during the last 12 months, no vaccination against these diseases has been carried out and imports of domestic cloven-hoofed animals vaccinated against these diseases are not permitted.;</p> <p>2.2. they have remained in the territory described under point 2.1 since birth, or for at least the last six months before dispatch to the European Community and without contact with imported cloven-hoofed animals for the last 30 days;</p> <p>2.3. they have remained in the holding(s) described under point I.11 since birth, or for at least 40 days prior to dispatch, and, during this period, in the holding(s) and in an area with a 20 km radius around the holding(s) of origin, there has been no case/outbreak of the diseases mentioned under point 2.1;</p> <p>2.4. they are not animals to be killed under a national programme for the eradication of diseases, nor have they been vaccinated against the diseases mentioned under point 2.1;</p> <p>2.5. they are / were (5) dispatched from their holding(s) of origin, without passing through any market, either directly to the European Community, (5) or to the officially authorised assembly centre described under point I.13 situated within the territory described under point 2.1, (5) and, until dispatched to the European Community:</p> <p>(a) they did not come in contact with other cloven-hoofed animals not complying with at least the same health requirements as described in this certificate, and</p> <p>(b) they were not at any place where, or around which within a 20 kms radius, during the previous 40 days there has been a case/outbreak of any of the diseases mentioned under point 2.1;</p> <p>2.6. any transport vehicles or containers in which they were loaded were cleaned and disinfected before loading with an officially authorised disinfectant;</p> <p>2.7. they were examined by an official veterinarian within 24 hours of loading and showed no clinical sign of disease;</p> <p>2.8. they have been loaded for dispatch to the European Community on (10) in the means of transport described under point I.15 above that were cleaned and disinfected before loading with an official authorised disinfectant and so constructed that faeces, urine, litter or fodder could not flow or fall out of the vehicle or container during transportation. 3.</p> <p>3.Animal transport attestation</p> <p>I, the undersigned official veterinarian, hereby certify, that the animals described above have been treated before and at the time of loading in accordance with the relevant provisions of Council Directive 91/628/EEC, in particular as regards watering and feeding, and they are fit for the intended transport.</p> <p>4.Specific requirements</p> <p>4.1. Aujeszky's disease is notifiable in the country referred to in point I.7;</p> <p>4.2. according to official information, no clinical, pathological or serological evidence of Aujeszky's disease has been recorded in the holding(s) of origin referred to in point I.11, for the last 3 months;</p> <p>4.3. the animals referred to in point I.28 :</p> <p>(a) have remained in the holding(s) of origin referred to in point I.11 since birth or for the last 60 days prior to dispatch for exportation, and</p> <p>(b) have not been vaccinated against Aujeszky's disease. Specify the identification system (i.e. tag, tattoos, brand, chip, transponder) and the anatomic place used in the animal,</p> <p>(b) an ear tag that includes the ISO code of the exporting country.</p> <p>(9) Age (months). Sex (M = male, F = female, C = castrated).</p> <p>(10) Date of loading. Imports of these animals shall not be allowed when the animals were loaded either prior to the date of authorisation for exportation to the European Community of the territory mentioned under (3), or during a period where restrictive measures have been adopted by the European Community against imports of these animals from this territory.</p> <p>(11) When required by the EU Member State of destination, in accordance with Commission Decision 2001/618/EC (as last amended).</p>
