	<p>I, the undersigned official veterinarian, declare that I am aware of the relevant provisions of Regulations (EC) Nos 178/2002, 852/2004, 853/2004 and 854/2004 and hereby certify that the meat of poultry(1) described in this certificate has been obtained in accordance with those requirements, and in particular that:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (a) (b) it has been produced in compliance with the conditions set out in Sections II and V of Annex III to Regulation (EC) No 853/2004. (c) it has been found fit for human consumption following ante and post-mortem inspections carried out in accordance with Section IV, Chapter V of Annex I to Regulation (EC) No 854/2004; (d) it has been marked with an identification mark in accordance with Section I of Annex II to Regulation (EC) No 853/2004; (e) it satisfies the relevant criteria set out in Regulation (EC) No 2073/2005 on microbiological criteria for foodstuffs; (f) (2) it fulfils the requirements of Regulation (EC) No 1688/2005 implementing Regulation (EC) No 853/2004 of the European Parliament and of the Council as regards special guarantees concerning salmonella for consignments to Finland and Sweden of certain meat and eggs; (g) the guarantees covering live animals and products thereof provided by the residue plans submitted in accordance with Directive 96/23/EC, and in particular Article 29 thereof, are fulfilled. <p>II.2. Animal health attestation</p> <p>I, the undersigned official veterinarian, hereby certify that the meat of poultry described in this certificate:</p> <p>II.2.1 (a) comes from the territory of code (3), which at the date of issue of the certificate was free from Avian influenza as defined in the International Animal Health Code of the OIE;</p> <p>(b) (4) comes from the territory of code : (3), which at the date of issue of the certificate was free from Newcastle disease as defined in the International Animal Health Code of the OIE;</p> <p>II.2.2 has been obtained from poultry which has been kept in the territory of code (3) since hatching or has been imported as day-old chicks;</p> <p>II.2.3 has been obtained from poultry coming from holdings:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (a) which have not been placed under animal-health restrictions in connection with any disease to which poultry is susceptible, (b) within a 10 km radius of which, including, where appropriate, the territory of a neighbouring country, there has been no outbreak of avian influenza or Newcastle disease for at least 30 days: <p>II.2.4 has been obtained from poultry that:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (a) has not been slaughtered under any animal-health scheme for the control or eradication of poultry diseases; (b) during transport to the slaughterhouse, did not come into contact with poultry infected with avian influenza or Newcastle disease; <p>II.2.5 (a) comes from approved slaughterhouses which, at the time of slaughter, were not under restrictions owing to a suspected or confirmed outbreak of avian influenza or Newcastle disease and within a 10 km radius of which there has been no outbreak of avian influenza or Newcastle disease for at least 30 days;</p> <p>(b) has not been in contact at any time during slaughter, cutting, storage or transport with poultry or meat of lower health status.</p> <p>(7) comes from a commercial slaughter poultry flock that:</p> <p>[II.2.6</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (a) has not been vaccinated with vaccines prepared from a Newcastle disease virus master seed showing a higher pathogenicity than lentogenic strains of the virus; (b) underwent a virus isolation test for Newcastle disease, carried out in an official laboratory at the time of slaughter on a random sample of cloacal swabs from at least 60 birds in each flock concerned and in which no avian paramyxoviruses with an Intracerebral Pathogenicity Index (ICPI) of more than 0.4 were found; (c) has not been in contact in 30 days preceding slaughter with poultry that does not fulfil the conditions in (a) and (b).] <p>II.3. Animal welfare attestation</p> <p>I, the undersigned official veterinarian, hereby certify that I have read and understood Directive 93/119/EC and that the meat described in this certificate comes from poultry that has been treated in accordance with the relevant provisions of Directive 93/119/EC in the slaughterhouse before and at the time of slaughter or killing.</p>
